

RESPONSIVENESS REPORT

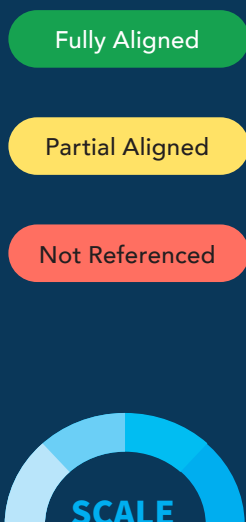
The Responsiveness Report provides an in-depth analysis of the B20 recommendations' adherence and alignment with the strategic objectives and statements made by the G20. It delivers a comprehensive overview of synergies, identifies potential domains for forthcoming policy implementation, and underscores the need for foundational agenda-setting in prioritized areas not contemplated by the G20 final outcomes.

METHODOLOGY

It was assessed the extent to which B20 recommendations and policy actions were acknowledged, contemplated, or incorporated into the G20 Leaders' Declaration, the Ministerial Declarations and Action Plans. The recommendations were classified into three tiers: Fully Aligned, Partially Aligned and Not Referenced.

For each recommendation, an average of coverage was calculated. This average resulted from the percentages of its corresponding policy actions, with the following scale:

- Fully Aligned (100%)
- Substantially Aligned (75%)
- Moderately Covered (50%)
- Marginally Covered (25%)
- Not Addressed (0%)



ASSESSMENT APPROACH

- 1 IN-DEPTH REVIEW**
Detailed analysis was conducted at the level of individual policy actions.
- 2 COMPREHENSIVE APPROACH**
Assessment included all G20 working groups, taskforces and initiatives declarations, including the Leaders' Declaration.
- 3 AGENDA-SETTING or POLICY IMPLEMENTATION**
Outcomes identify opportunities for policy implementation or agenda-setting advocacy.
